Summary of Purpose: Provides library services and programming to meet customers' information and entertainment needs with special emphasis on the needs of children and teens.

Collection Quality Ensures a broad and balanced collection that represents the interests of the community.

- Stays familiar with programming resource books.
- Stays familiar with current publishing trends and customer interests with the aid of popular media, customer requests and discussion with the other Youth Services staff.
- Assists in shelving, monitoring, rotating and weeding the collection.
- Monitors physical integrity of materials.
- Reports title or subject suggestions to supervisor.

Service Quality Ensures service excellence through customer focused standards and consistently applied policies.

- Provides direct service to customers of all ages with special attention given to children, young adults, and their caregivers.
- Addresses customer concerns and complaints. Refers them to supervisor when appropriate.
- Retrieves information via computer, and is knowledgeable of the Library's policies and procedures.
- Performs clerical tasks essential to daily operations.
- Fills in for other youth services staff (in home branch and other locations) as needed.
- Attends regular staff meetings to review and discuss customer needs, library policies, and procedures.
- Keeps abreast of developments by reading professional literature and attending conferences, workshops, and other training sessions. Incorporates new developments into daily practices.

Access Quality Ensures public awareness and access to Library resources through promotion, education and collaboration.

- Conducts literature-based library programs for the enrichment of children, teens and families.
- Helps with youth services programming throughout the library system.
- Encourages young readers and promotes library use as a rewarding experience for children and teens.
- Creates and maintains displays targeted at children and young adults.
- Creates programming materials (e.g. flannel stories) under guidance of youth services staff.
- Presents programs for schools and other youth oriented organizations.
- Conducts tours of the library.
- Ensures that library equipment is in good working order, troubleshoots simple technology problems when they arise, and notifies technology staff of serious issues.

Facility Quality Ensures facilities that are safe, functional and inviting.

- Maintains the orderliness and organization of department collections.
- Keeps work areas clean and safe.
- Monitors customer usage of the library facilities and takes a proactive approach in preventing disruptive or unsafe behavior or conditions.
- Cleans areas and materials in assigned departments as needed.
- Reports any serious maintenance problems to the library's maintenance staff.

Resource Quality Ensures adequate resources through public and private funding, gifts, donations, partnerships and the deployment of volunteers.

- Maintains the library's reputation and positive image in the community to facilitate fundraising and related activities.
- Assists in the supervision of volunteers as needed.

- Degree related to education or children's services preferred.
- Prior experience working with children preferred.
