# HOW TO PLAY:

- Mark five spaces in a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal line to make a BINGO.
- Once you have a BINGO, return the card to any Delaware County District Library branch before August 4 to be entered into the prize drawing.
- Each title you read may be used to mark only one space on the BINGO card.
- You may turn in multiple BINGO cards for multiple entries in the prize drawing. However, you may not count any titles already used on a previous BINGO card.
- Titles may be any format that you prefer: print, ebook, or audio.
